

## JOIN US IN PRAYER – APRIL 2026

<b>Week 1:</b>	<b>APRIL 1-3 – REACH BEYOND MISSIONARIES AND STAFF</b>
<b>WED 1</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for technical expertise in resolving some transmission issues with Radio Vida FM 95.1 in Spain. The signal has been faltering over the last few weeks. Ask God to help us quickly find and fix the problem between the studio and the transmitter.
<b>THU 2</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for our missionaries and staff who are in the midst of transitions in life and ministry. Pray for our missionaries as they go on Home Ministry Assignment to reconnect with churches, supporters, and spend time with family. Ask God to give them rest during what is often a hectic season of ministry. Pray they would be a blessing as they share how God is working through them.
<b>FRI 3</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for our missionaries as they minister to people all around the world. Ask God to help them build relationships that open doors for spiritual conversations. Pray that God would give our people the wisdom and strength they need for each day.
<b>SAT &amp; SUN 4-5</b>	<b>WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS   Dhanuk</b> <b>Country:</b> India   <b>Population:</b> 4,246,000   <b>Language:</b> Hindi   <b>Main Religion:</b> Hinduism   <b>Evangelical:</b> 0.0-0.1% The Dhanuk are a low caste or a minority indigenous people. Many Dhanuk work as agricultural laborers or serve as household help for wealthy landlords and the affluent. Almost all worship Hindu deities, bringing food, flowers, and incense in the hope of earning protection and benefits. The Dhanuk are split into two groups. Those who worship the Hindu goddess Kali will eat pork and drink alcohol, while the rest do not. The Dhanuk also believe in magic, witchcraft, and ghosts. To drive ghosts away, they will put branches from a specific tree and unwanted shoes by the main gate of their house. Pray for the few Dhanuk believers and the churches scattered among them. Pray that the Dhanuk would hear the Good News of Jesus and choose to follow Him.
<b>Week 2:</b>	<b>APRIL 6-10 – PRAY FOR MINISTRIES IN SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA</b>
<b>MON 6</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for the Lord's protection to surround Alfred during his trip to South Sudan this week to provide much needed technical training to our radio partner and their network of stations. It is not uncommon for civil unrest to erupt amidst the ongoing conflict in the country. Ask God to multiply and expand the ministry of these radio stations so that many more people would follow Jesus.
<b>TUE 7</b>	<b>PRAISE</b> God for the meetings that Wim, Emmanuel, and Alex had during their trip to Sierra Leone to discuss planting a new radio station and for new water projects with our partner. Pray for God's blessings and provision as we move forward with these plans.
<b>WED 8</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for our new community development partner in Northern Mozambique as they begin to utilize the WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene) training that we taught them. Pray for these believers as they give their first training in two rural communities.
<b>THU 9</b>	<b>PRAY</b> that God would bring together just the right team of volunteers to join our team going to Benin this July to: check the wells, meet the people, and tell their stories. <b>FRI 10</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for the participants of a well repair and installation course that Reach Beyond Netherlands is providing in partnership with Friends in Action International. We are planning for ministry partners from Sierra Leone, Cameroon, and Mali to attend this year's course in the Ivory Coast.
<b>SAT &amp; SUN 11-12</b>	<b>WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS   Sudanese Arab</b> <b>Country:</b> Sudan   <b>Population:</b> 15,948,000   <b>Language:</b> Arabic, Sudanese   <b>Main Religion:</b> Islam   <b>Evangelical:</b> 0.0-0.1% Most Sudanese Arabs live in small villages made up of clusters of mud-brick homes. The majority live off of what they can grow: grains, vegetables, and cotton, as well as raising livestock. Some live in towns and cities where they have jobs in various trades and more opportunities for education and economic prosperity. Still other Sudanese Arabs continue the nomadic life of their ancestors, traveling from place to place with their camels and herd. Sudan's recent history has been filled with genocide, civil war, terror, and destruction, resulting in the deaths of more than 2,500,000 people and the displacement of millions more. Pray that God would bring an end to the conflicts and atrocities in Sudan and South Sudan. Ask God to move in the hearts of family and clan leaders. Pray they would choose to follow Jesus—the Prince of Peace.
<b>Week 3:</b>	<b>APRIL 13-17 – PRAY FOR MINISTRIES IN EUROPE/EURASIA</b>
<b>MON 13</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for our partner Sahar, who leads the OneHeart medical ministry among Farsi-speaking Iranian and Afghan refugees in Athens, Greece. She cares pastorally for many, many Iranian people and is deeply burdened by the situation in Iran. Pray too for many of her relatives who have been impacted by both the recent crackdown on protests and now the military actions.
<b>TUE 14</b>	<b>PRAISE</b> God for what He is doing through one of our community development projects in a restrictive country. The women's home group is studying the Gospel of John as well as going through some "basics of the Bible" for new believers. Our team is excited to see these believers begin a new season as they learn to walk with Jesus.

<b>WED 15</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for the launching of a new community development project in another village where we have done medical work in the past. Pray for the missionaries and local believers who will be involved with all of the different classes and programs, as it is a huge endeavor and requires a lot of unity and cooperation. Pray that this project will open the hearts of this community to the Gospel.
<b>THU 16</b>	<b>PRAISE</b> God for the new local administrator at our clinic in a restrictive country, who is really active with great ideas for running the clinic and ministries. Pray that God would provide a local professional who can work in our physical therapy room.
<b>FRI 17</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for our missionary doctors who are running a palliative care ministry in a restrictive country. Ask God to give their team resilience as they currently have a few tough cases. Praise God that they have been able to help support a marriage ministry seminar course each month, which is opening up topics and conversations that are not often had in church.
<b>SAT &amp; SUN 18-19</b>	<b>WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS   Bouyei</b> <b>Country:</b> China   <b>Population:</b> 3,577,000   <b>Language:</b> Bouyei   <b>Main Religion:</b> Ethnic Religions   <b>Evangelical:</b> 0.1-2.0% The Bouyei are one of the ancient peoples of Guizhou and one of the 55 official minorities in China. They were once known as the Chunchia, or "people in the middle." Thousands of Bouyei were burned at the stake during the Nanlang Rebellion of 1797, which caused many to flee to Vietnam. The government ended education in the Bouyei language in 1995. Only 12% of the Bouyei have attended high school. The Bouyei are polytheists. Superstitions rule their lives, and shamans are hired to cast out demons of illness or bad fortune. Pray for church planting efforts among the Bouyei. Pray that they would recognize that Jesus has power over all of the creatures of darkness and that they would find hope, life, peace, and freedom in Him.
<b>Week 4:</b>	<b>APRIL 20-24 – PRAY FOR MINISTRIES IN NORTH AFRICA/MIDDLE EAST</b>
<b>MON 20</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for the English learners that we have befriended through social media who have been directly impacted by the situation in the Middle East. Pray for peace in the region and for a quick end to the conflict. Pray that many people would find hope in Jesus.
<b>TUE 21</b>	<b>PRAISE</b> God that work on the radiotherapy clinic at the Mbingo Baptist Hospital has resumed after making more funds available to the contractor. Pray for the team as they work with a fundraiser and ask God to provide what is needed to complete the project.
<b>WED 22</b>	<b>PRAISE</b> God for a contact in Spain who is distributing some of our audio players and Bibles written in a local indigenous dialect called Rif. This language is spoken along the coast of Morocco, and there are speakers of this dialect living in southern Spain.
<b>THU 23</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for God's guidance as we consider the future of shortwave radio broadcasts in the Berber language to North Africa. There is a critical need for new content. Please pray for our team as they seek the Lord's will in continuing with shortwave broadcasts or moving to an online streaming platform.
<b>FRI 24</b>	<b>PRAISE</b> God for renewed interest in the local prison ministry in Spain. Pray as we look to provide Spanish Bibles to the pastors who are sharing Jesus and making disciples among inmates, workers, and their families.
<b>SAT &amp; SUN 25-26</b>	<b>WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS   Persian</b> <b>Country:</b> Iran   <b>Population:</b> 44,315,000   <b>Language:</b> Persian   <b>Main Religion:</b> Islam   <b>Evangelical:</b> 0.1-2.0% Persians have a rich history of kings, kingdoms, poetry, art, and advances in math and science. Their last king (or shah) was overthrown by Islamic revolutionists in 1979. Iran then became an Islamic nation ruled by the Ayatollah, or religious leader. Persians are very devoted to family, gathering together almost every day. Iranian law dictates that women cover their heads and wear special dress in public. Most women abide by these rules since penalties can be very severe. While the majority of Persians profess to being Muslim and believing in the Prophet Mohammed, some estimate that less than 10 percent strictly follow the practice of Islam. Many Persians are open to other religious beliefs. Pray for evangelization efforts since witnessing is illegal and conversion carries severe punishments. Pray for religious freedom in the country so churches can meet legally and openly.
<b>Week 5:</b>	<b>APRIL 27-30 – PRAY FOR MINISTRIES IN ASIA PACIFIC</b>
<b>MON 27</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for Trevor as he returns to a restrictive country in Asia Pacific to complete the first stage in setting up a studio for a radio plant with our new local partner. Pray for these young believers who are preparing to build a new internet channel and will soon begin recording Scripture in their own languages.
<b>TUE 28</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for Rachel as she begins a 3-month sabbatical. Pray that this time will both refresh and prepare her for ministry when she returns. Pray for her co-worker, Joy, as she leads the learning center that is ministering to Rohingya families.
<b>WED 29</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for one of our local radio partners who wants us to help them launch a new radio station. Ask God to change the hearts of the local government officials who are reluctant to allow Christians to operate a station there. Pray that God would make His will clear by removing every obstacle or by opening up a different location where believers can run a radio ministry.
<b>THU 30</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for a family in a restricted country who listen to our media project even though they are not believers. They said, "It keeps our focus; having the radio and other sermons playing in the background is a huge help for us in learning about God and His truth." Pray that everyone in this family will soon believe and choose to walk with Jesus.
