sat & sun <b>6-7</b>	WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS   Uyghur Country: China   Population: 11,768,000   Language: Uyghur   Main Religion: Islam   Evangelical: 0.01% The Uyghurs, Turkic farmers from western China, live in a region known as East Turkestan and may be the best-known people of Central Asia. They have a rich cultural history going back almost 4,000 years. Nestorian missionaries first appeared in Central Asia during the 500s AD. By the 12th and 13th centuries, roughly eight million people were considered Christian. Islam also began taking root at that time and became the dominant religion by the 1400s. Swedish missionaries planted a small Uyghur church during the1890s. In 1933, Abdullah Khan expelled the missionaries and martyred the Uyghur believers. Today, most Uyghurs practice a superstitious form of Sunni Islam. Chinese authorities heavily persecute them. Pray that the Gospel would take root among the Uyghurs and bring hope to the millions detained in internment camps. Pray that Han Chinese Christians would serve faithfully as Jesus' voice and hands to those who are suffering and would be an encouragement and support to the tiny Uyghur church.

SAT & SUN 20-21	WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS   Shwe Palaung Country: Myanmar   Population: 233,000   Language: Shwe Palaung   Main Religion: Buddhism   Evangelical: 0.12% The Shwe (Golden) Palaung are one of several Palaung peoples living among the heavily wooded mountains and valleys of Shan State in northeastern Myanmar. The Shwe Palaung live among their neighbors, the Shan, who once ruled much of Myanmar. They speak their own Palaung dialect. Some are bilingual, capable of speaking either Burmese or Shan outside the home. Myanmar's history of political unrest and ethnic enmity has created a history of strife and conflict going back to the 11th century. Today, the Palaung and other ethnic groups fight for government recognition but often find themselves caught in an armed conflict against their wishes. Most are slash-and-burn farmers who live in large, elevated homes with their extended family. The Palaung practice a fusion of Buddhism and animism and seek to please the spirits. Pray for God to send laborers who will deliver His peace and rest. Ask God to deliver the Palaung from violence and spiritual darkness.
Week 4:	JANUARY 22-26 – PRAY FOR MINISTRIES IN NORTH AFRICA / MIDDLE EAST
мол 22	<b>PRAY</b> for two new short-term missionaries as they spend time in the region from January to March. Ask God to grant them a fruitful time of ministry in the region. Pray that God will show them opportunities for future full-time service and give them wisdom and discernment as they pursue His calling for their lives.
TUE 23	<b>PRAY</b> for the ongoing search for board members for Radio Vida and Puentes. Pray that God will allow us to find like-minded individuals who share the vision of ministering to the region and to Spain.
WED 24	<b>PRAISE</b> God for Radio Vida's new program geared toward youth. Pray that this new ministry, called "La Resistencia," will be a bridge that creates new opportunities for local churches to reach more young people in the area.
тни <b>25</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for one of our new Ephraim Project volunteers who is struggling with the technology needed to interact with the English learners. Ask God to clear up any technical issues and remove all other barriers to engaging in this ministry.
FRI <b>26</b>	<b>PRAY</b> for God to provide funding for shortwave broadcasts to a North African people group. There are no known believers among this group, and reaching them with the Gospel using traditional missions strategies is virtually impossible.
SAT & SUN <b>27-28</b>	WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS   Chenoua Country: Algeria   Population: 106,000   Language: Chenoua   Main Religion: Islam   Evangelical: 0.00% The Muslim Chenoua are one of many Berber peoples scattered across North Africa. They live along Algeria's Mediterranean coast in the shadow of Mount Chenoua. They speak one of three distinct dialects, yet Chenoua speakers can understand each other regardless of dialect. Today, many parents teach their children Arabic to increase educational opportunities, but kids still pick up Chenoua at home. Civil war and threats from terrorist groups have pushed many to abandon their villages in favor of larger towns and cities. When they move, many stop speaking Chenoua. The only known Chenoua Christians live outside of Algeria. Pray that the Chenoua will hear the Gospel in their native tongue. Ask God to open doors and remove obstacles for Christians to enter the country and share the Good News. Pray for opportunities for Christians to establish schools and hospitals among the Chenoua. Pray for the completion of a Chenoua Bible.
Week 5:	JANUARY 29-31 – PRAY FOR MINISTRIES IN EUROPE/EURASIA
мон 29	<b>PRAY</b> for one of our missionary families who is moving houses this month. Pray that the transition goes smoothly. Ask for an extra measure of grace as they undergo the difficulties and stresses of moving while living in another culture.
TUE 30	<b>PRAY</b> for staff at the new medical clinic that opened in October. Ask God to guide and bless their efforts as they train local medical professionals in their specialties and in leadership skills. Pray for continued professional and spiritual growth.
wed 31	<b>PRAISE</b> for ongoing medical caravans in Central Asia. Ask for these outreaches to open doors for new relationships and new opportunities to share the Gospel with unbelievers. Pray also that caravan staff would equip and encourage local believers to demonstrate and share the love of Christ with their families, friends, and neighbors with wisdom and boldness.
