

JOIN US IN PRAYER – MARCH 2026

Week 1: MARCH 2-6 – PRAY FOR MINISTRIES IN SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA	
MON 2	PRAY for Alex and Wim as they will be traveling and meeting with two partners in West Africa later this month. Pray for their discussions as they make plans with our partner for future water well projects in Togo, and then discuss plans for a new community development initiative and a new radio station project in Sierra Leone.
TUE 3	PRAISE God for the WASH training (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene) that Wim and Jonny were able to carry out in northern Mozambique with two different ministries. Please pray for the first water project that we are planning to do with a local radio ministry there for a community that is in serious need of clean water.
WED 4	PRAISE God for the successful online course last month to help radio ministries learn more about addressing political news and elections on the air. Give thanks for the staff from Radio Worldwide and Reach Beyond Asia Pacific who helped teach the material.
THU 5	PRAISE God that our engineer Alfred and volunteer Colin were able to set up a new recording studio for a Christian radio station in northern Ivory Coast. We are excited and rejoicing with them for this new studio that they will use to record songs in their own local languages that they can play on their station, and to generate revenue that will help sustain their ministry.
FRI 6	PRAY for the upcoming short-term trip to Benin in July that will focus on creating media that tells the story of how the Gospel has impacted communities. Ask God to send us who He would choose to be part of a diverse team of creative people!
SAT & SUN 7-8	WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS Jula Country: Ivory Coast Population: 2,229,000 Language: Jula Main Religion: Islam Evangelical: 0.1-2.0% The Jula people, also known as Dyula, were skilled craftsmen and traders of gold and kola nuts beginning in the 1500s. They held high status as merchants for centuries, and eventually their trading posts morphed into market villages and cities. Jula have been Muslim since the 1400s, but they maintain good relations with non-Muslim neighbors, trying to convert them by setting a good example rather than by force. They are fiercely loyal to their clans, and they maintain their cultural history through the oral traditions of dance and storytelling. The best way to present the Gospel to the Jula is probably orally and at the clan level. Pray that radio broadcasts would reach the hearts of the Jula people. Pray that leaders of the Jula clans would come to know Christ, and that God would begin a disciple-making movement that will spread the Gospel throughout all Jula villages.
Week 2: MARCH 9-13 – PRAY FOR MINISTRIES IN EUROPE/EURASIA	
MON 9	PRAY for the eight doctors, mid-level providers, and nurses who will be serving for 4-8 weeks alongside our medical team in a restrictive country. Pray for them as they teach, train, mentor, and build relationships in the medical professional sphere and serve people in rural areas.
TUE 10	PRAY for the students, teachers, and chaperones from an international school as they gather with other schools in the region for a time of worship. Pray that God would watch over them as they travel and that everything would go smoothly. Pray that God would use this event to encourage and speak into the lives of each one who is there.
WED 11	PRAY for Martin and Ruth as they participate in a Vision Day with the Reach Beyond Sweden team later this month. Pray that God would give them discernment, direction, and clarity as they seek to follow His leading.
THU 12	PRAISE God for giving us the opportunity to open a community center in a Gospel-restrictive country. Pray for the different outreaches that have already begun to share the love of Christ through action and service. Pray that many people would come to know Jesus as their Savior through this ministry.
FRI 13	PRAY for our team in a restrictive country as they gather together for a retreat at the end of March. Pray that they and their children will enjoy this time of fellowship together. Ask God to encourage them as they serve in places where it is easy to feel very isolated and alone. Pray that they would be refreshed, renewed, and restored.
SAT & SUN 14-15	WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS Yagnob Country: Tajikistan Population: 33,000 Language: Tajik Main Religion: Islam Evangelical: 0.0-0.1% The Yagnob are an ethnic minority with a difficult past. They were forcibly relocated by helicopter from their homes in the Yagnob Mountains to the semi-desert lowlands of Tajikistan by the Soviets in 1957 and 1970. Once there, they were forced by communist officials into hard labor—working on cotton plantations. The backbreaking work caused several hundred Yagnob to die. In 1983, they began returning to their homeland in the Yagnob Valley. Like most Tajik people, they are Sunni Muslims who try to obey the teachings of the Quran and the prophet Mohammed. There are no Christian resources in the Yagnobi language, and probably no followers of Jesus in the tribe. Pray that God would open their hearts to the Gospel and bring them into His kingdom soon.
Week 3: MARCH 16-20 – PRAY FOR MINISTRIES IN NORTH AFRICA/MIDDLE EAST	

MON 16	PRAY for the Ephraim Project team and the English learners they engage with on social media. Many of these English learners are living in a complex and difficult situation where protests are being actively and violently suppressed. Pray that God would open many doors for us to share the hope of Jesus with them. Ask God to protect believers who are facing increased persecution.
TUE 17	PRAISE God for the many lives that are being impacted through our Arabic media partnership. In 2025, over 795 people prayed to accept Jesus and 972 were disciplined. Praise God for what He has done and pray that many more will soon put their trust in Jesus.
WED 18	PRAY for southern Spain as it was hit by several severe storms in late January and February, leading to widespread damage to infrastructure in the region. The storms and heavy rains also caused damage to underground power cables at our regional office and the loss of power. Pray that those who have been affected would see God's love demonstrated through His people.
THU 19	PRAISE God for the progress that has been made in resolving technical issues at the Trash 2 Treasure installation in Athens, Greece. Pray for this ministry as they seek to reach people who have been marginalized by society. Pray that these unreached people would realize how much God loves them and accept His invitation to experience new life through Jesus.
FRI 20	PRAY for the Mbingo Baptist Hospital radiotherapy project as construction has stalled due to contract issues. Pray that God would help resolve these challenges and provide the resources needed to complete the project.
SAT & SUN 21-22	WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS Afshari Country: Iran Population: 416,000 Language: Azerbaijani, South Main Religion: Islam Evangelical: 0.0-0.1% The Afshari are semi-nomadic people who arrived in Iran in the 11th century. They were traditionally shepherds, and many today still move with their herds each spring and fall in search of better pastures. Large families live together in tents that are hand-woven from goat hair. The Afshari are also known as highly skilled weavers of rugs and other decorative items—early examples can be quite valuable. Most Afshari now have jobs outside of the home. They have followed Islam for many centuries and are proud of their Muslim identity. The Afshari have been very resistant to the Gospel—there are no known believers. The Afshari love to listen to music, and most have a radio. Pray that they would hear the Gospel through radio, the Jesus Film, or acquire the Scripture in their own language. Pray that God would open their hearts to learn about the Good Shepherd who wants to lead them to His green pastures and still waters.
Week 4:	MARCH 23-27 – PRAY FOR MINISTRIES IN ASIA PACIFIC
MON 23	PRAY for Anita as she travels to an island in central Indonesia this month to mentor a young station manager. While there, she hopes to help assess equipment needs for an electrical grounding project that will begin later this year.
TUE 24	PRAY for a radio station in the north of Indonesia whose broadcast tower collapsed at the end of January because of a tornado. Pray that repairs would happen quickly so listeners can again hear the Good News of Jesus.
WED 25	PRAISE God that a radio station on a remote island in eastern-central Indonesia will be able to go back on the air after having been shut down several years ago. Pray for the local church that has adopted this project and ask God to help them as they seek radio announcers, staff, and resources to run the ministry.
THU 26	PRAY for the development of a new-format course for junior radio announcers in Indonesia, which Janice and Anita will teach remotely using Zoom. Pray for the students who will be receiving the training and that everything will run smoothly as planned.
FRI 27	PRAY for many listeners to be touched by the short devotional, "Friends in Faith", which Janice is writing for our local partners to translate and produce as radio programs for three different countries in the Asia Pacific region.
SAT & SUN 28-29	WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS Sasak Country: Indonesia Population: 3,497,000 Language: Sasak Main Religion: Islam Evangelical: 0.0-0.1% The Sasak are predominantly found on Lombok Island, which is just east of Bali. Most are farmers, while others work as fishermen or craftsmen. Some Sasak are highly skilled in making weavings or earthenware items that are sold to tourists and exported abroad. Almost all Sasak are Muslims. Each year, many of them will go to great lengths and personal sacrifice to travel to Mecca. They know that by completing the Haj, they will be highly honored by family and neighbors for the rest of their lives. Many Sasak people continue to worship the spirits of ancestors and spirits who live in the forest, mountains, or rivers. They also try to appease evil spirits with offerings of food, flowers, and incense. Pray for church-planting efforts among the Sasak. Pray that they would recognize that Jesus is more powerful than the evil spirits that they fear, and that He alone is the one they should worship.
Week 5:	MARCH 30-31 – PRAY FOR REACH BEYOND MISSIONARIES AND STAFF
MON 30	PRAY for God's miraculous healing and comfort for our many people, partners, and friends of the mission who are in the midst of significant health issues. Ask God to fill them with peace in the midst of uncertainty. Pray that God would give wisdom to those who are providing them with care. Pray that they will see and experience God's grace in their lives each day.
TUE 31	PRAY for our missionaries who are often far away from family and loved ones who are experiencing life challenges. Pray that God would give our people wisdom so they would know what to do in every situation. Pray that God will give our missionaries peace and comfort as they speak into what can be very difficult situations, and help provide emotional and spiritual support.
