

JOIN US IN PRAYER – SEPTEMBER 2026

Week 1:	SEPTEMBER 1-4 – PRAY FOR MINISTRIES IN NORTH AFRICA/MIDDLE EAST
TUE 1	PRAY for our Arabic media partners as they create content to help point people towards Jesus. Ask God to give the team of ministers wisdom as they directly engage in conversations with people who are seeking answers and searching for truth.
WED 2	PRAISE God for the many testimonies of what He is doing through our Arabic media partnership. Pray for the follow-up team as they disciple new believers and help them become part of church fellowships located throughout the region. Pray that many people would see the light of the Gospel through the lives of these new believers, and choose to follow Jesus too.
THU 3	PRAY for God's people and the persecuted church in North Africa and the Middle East and the many challenges they face. Ask God to encourage them, protect them, and give them peace. Pray that they will grow strong in their faith.
FRI 4	PRAY that God would send us more short-term and long-term missionaries who are willing to give of their time, talents, and abilities to help reach this region with the Gospel. Ask God to also bring us more English-speaking volunteers who are willing to invest an hour or two a week to engage in online/virtual conversations with small groups of people who want to practice speaking English.
SAT & SUN 5-6	WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS Moor Country: Mauritania Population: 4,418,000 Language: Hassaniya Main Religion: Islam Evangelical: 0.0-0.1% The Moor people are a subset of the Berbers, who descended from an Arab/Tuareg tribe. When the Arabs conquered North Africa in the 600s and 700s, the Tuareg helped them spread Islam across the region to the west coast of Africa. The Moors and other Berber tribes grew in influence and would rule much of the Iberian Peninsula up until 1492, when Spanish Monarchs regained control. In 1609, the Moors were expelled to North Africa, where they were persecuted for following their particular form of Sunni Islam. They fled to the desert where they took up the nomadic lifestyle as skilled tradesmen. Pray for opportunities for missionaries to live and work among the Moors. Pray that the Holy Spirit would open their minds and hearts to the truth of the Gospel. Pray that Moors would see Jesus as more than a prophet and receive Him as their personal Lord and Savior.
Week 2:	SEPTEMBER 7-11 – PRAY FOR MINISTRIES IN SUB-SAHARAN AFRICA
MON 7	PRAISE God for the newest member of our media training team — Marie from Cameroon! We have been working alongside Marie on various projects in Africa during the last 10 years. She has a passion for helping the underserved Christian radio stations in French-speaking countries throughout Africa to thrive in their mission!
TUE 8	PRAY for Marie as she represents Reach Beyond at the AbR Media conference in a "Do Not Travel" country. Pray as she delivers training to a YWAM team who wants to use radio/digital media to reach that place. Pray for us as we look at providing more training to Christian radio stations in that nation, including our Training of Trainers course to empower future Christian media trainers.
WED 9	PRAISE God for the training that Benjamin was able to provide in Madagascar after the 10th year anniversary celebrations of Radio Feon Janahary. Benjamin was also able to visit villages and meet listeners to see the station's impact first-hand. So many people depend on this station, and it has been a true lifeline for most of them. Praise God for all of the people who have come to know the Lord through this ministry, and for the many churches that have sprung up and are now thriving.
THU 10	PRAY for Alfred as he works to repair a broken audio mixer and a transmitter from two stations in Togo, that depend on this equipment to broadcast the Gospel to unreached communities in the north of the country. Pray that Alfred will be able to diagnose and resolve the issues quickly.
FRI 11	PRAY for the upcoming water pump repair and installation training for partners who are wanting to use community development to bring the Gospel to unreached communities in northern Ghana. Pray that God would arrange everything in His perfect timing.
SAT & SUN 12-13	WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS Tama Country: Chad Population: 254,000 Language: Tama Main Religion: Islam Evangelical: 0.0-0.1% The Tama live in a small area on both sides of the border between Chad and Sudan. Years of conflict, war, and severe drought have deeply impacted the Tama and caused them to flee or seek refuge across the border. They live in a harsh climate that rarely allows them to grow more crops than what they need to survive. What little livestock they have is often stolen by bandits or other tribes. Many Tama live in extreme poverty with little hope, and alcohol brewed from millet is a tempting escape. Pray that God would open up opportunities for more believers to live and work among the Tama, especially in areas of community development, clean water, education, and relief. Pray that the Tama would seek and find refuge in Jesus, who deeply cares for them.
Week 3:	SEPTEMBER 14-18 – PRAY FOR MINISTRIES IN EUROPE/EURASIA
MON 14	PRAY for a team of Reach Beyond mission workers who are leading a media training course in a restricted-access country this month. Pray for them as they strengthen and build a partnership with an on-the-ground church network to mobilize media missionaries for evangelism, discipleship, and church growth in that nation.

TUE 15	PRAISE God for our online media ministries in a former Soviet country. Our team there has just launched a redesigned app and website that will help them overcome frequent technological interruptions and boost listener engagement. Pray as they organize a music festival and raise funds locally for ongoing ministry despite many political and economic challenges across their nation.
WED 16	PRAY for wisdom and excellence as our Balkans media team collaborates with Trans World Radio to translate, adapt, and record some 1,200 half-hour episodes of "Through the Bible" in the Croatian language over the next five years. These radio programs were originally created by Dr. J. Vernon McGee to systematically go through all 66 books of the Bible.
THU 17	PRAISE God for some wonderful season-ending celebrations for our community development project in a Gospel-restrictive country. Several of the women's groups were able to go on picnics and spend an afternoon together sharing about how they enjoyed the project and how they grew from the group discussions. Pray for the local project leaders and the director as they build on what they've learned and begin a new year of ministry. Pray that the project would become more robust and sustainable..
FRI 18	PRAY for the new school year at an International Christian Academy where several of our missionary kids attend. Pray that the teachers, both veteran and new, will quickly adjust to their roles, their students, and assigned curriculum. Pray that each student will find joy in learning and that they would choose to walk in God's ways.
SAT & SUN 19-20	WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS Nogai Country: Russia Population: 110,000 Language: Nogai Main Religion: Islam Evangelical: 0.0-0.1% The Nogai are a Mongol-Turkic people who live in and around the Caucasus Mountains and claim descent from Nogai Khan, a general of the Golden Horde and the great-great-grandson of Genghis Khan. These patriarchal people were once nomadic warriors but now live in small villages where they farm and raise livestock. Much like their Mongol ancestors, the Nogai enjoy horse racing, archery, wrestling, and falconry. They are famous for Nogai tea, a hot black tea prepared using boiling milk, butter, salt, and pepper. The Nogai practice Sunni Islam influenced by folk religion. They believe that to be Nogai is to be Muslim. There are only about 20 known Nogai Christians. Pray that the Nogai would want to read the Scriptures and learn more about Jesus.
Week 4:	SEPTEMBER 21-25 – MINISTRIES IN ASIA PACIFIC
MON 21	PRAY for our efforts to reach the Rohingya people. Pray especially for the learning center as it is experiencing prejudice from nearby residents who resent the Rohingya's presence in their neighborhood and community. Pray for God's protection and that through this situation, Jesus's love would be clearly visible to both the Rohingya and their neighbors.
TUE 22	PRAISE God for the completion of 24 SuperBible videos in the Bahasa Indonesia language last month. Pray for our partners as they begin posting these superhero-style animated Bible stories on their social media channels. Pray that many listeners would share these videos with their friends and on social networks. Pray that many lives would be changed by hearing God's word.
WED 23	PRAY for one of our partners in a very Gospel-restrictive country who has begun producing content for their new online radio station. Ask God to send more people to join their team who are passionate about using digital media platforms to share the Good News of Jesus with the millions of unreached people in their country.
THU 24	PRAISE God for what Trevor was able to accomplish during a recent trip to help our radio partners in a restricted country. Praise God that we were able to help install a new grounding/lightning protection system for one station as well as assess and repair broadcast equipment used at other stations.
FRI 25	PRAY for Anita as she visits radio stations to encourage and mentor staff and provide training. Ask God to give her wisdom as each station has its own unique set of challenges and circumstances. Pray that God would help her as she works with them to discover ways they can become more financially sustainable. Pray that God would use this training to provide what each station needs.
SAT & SUN 26-27	WEEKEND PRAYER FOR UNREACHED PEOPLE GROUPS Tharu Country: Nepal Population: 1,906,000 Language: Hindi Main Religion: Hinduism Evangelical: Unknown The Tharu people are an ethnic group indigenous to southern Nepal and northern India. They are a gentle people who live quiet, simple lives. They make everything they need and then add a touch of beauty or art to it. The important leaders in the community are the village headman—the Bharra who treats disease, and the Desi-Mahajan who is the moneylender. While their focus has been mostly on local concerns, they have become more aware of outside issues and discuss them during their fireside chats. Pray for Christian witnesses and disciples to live among them. Pray for the Tharu to be convicted of their sins and that they would be receptive to the Good News of Jesus.
Week 5:	SEPTEMBER 28-30 – PRAY FOR REACH BEYOND MISSIONARIES AND STAFF
MON 28	PRAY for our missionaries, staff, retirees, partners, and friends of the mission who are in the midst of significant medical challenges. Pray for God's healing. Ask God to give wisdom to the doctors and people who are providing care. Pray that God's grace would be sufficient to meet their every need. Pray that they would experience His strength and peace each day.
TUE 29	PRAY for Janice as she continues to produce devotional content for our radio partners in Thailand and Indonesia. Pray for those who are translating and voicing the radio programs in local languages. Pray that these devotionals would be encouragement to both Christians and non-believers. Pray that they would lead many listeners to want to know more about Jesus.
WED 30	PRAY for our missionary families as they readjust to life and ministry on the field after serving on Home Ministry Assignment. Praise God for the opportunities they had to share about what God is doing through their ministry, and to personally reconnect with many individual ministry partners, churches, friends, and family.
